Step-by-step

How to Add Pins to a Curriculum Map

1. Click on **Trackers** , then click on **Curriculum Maps**. Open the curriculum map you want to add resources to.
2. On your curriculum map, you can add resource pins to units, standards, or to the entire map. Hover over the menu button for the map, unit, or standard and click on **Add Resource Pin**.
