




# View and Customize Standards in a Curriculum Map

## How to View and Customize a Standard in a Curriculum Map

1. Click on **Trackers**, then click on **Curriculum Maps**. Select your curriculum map.

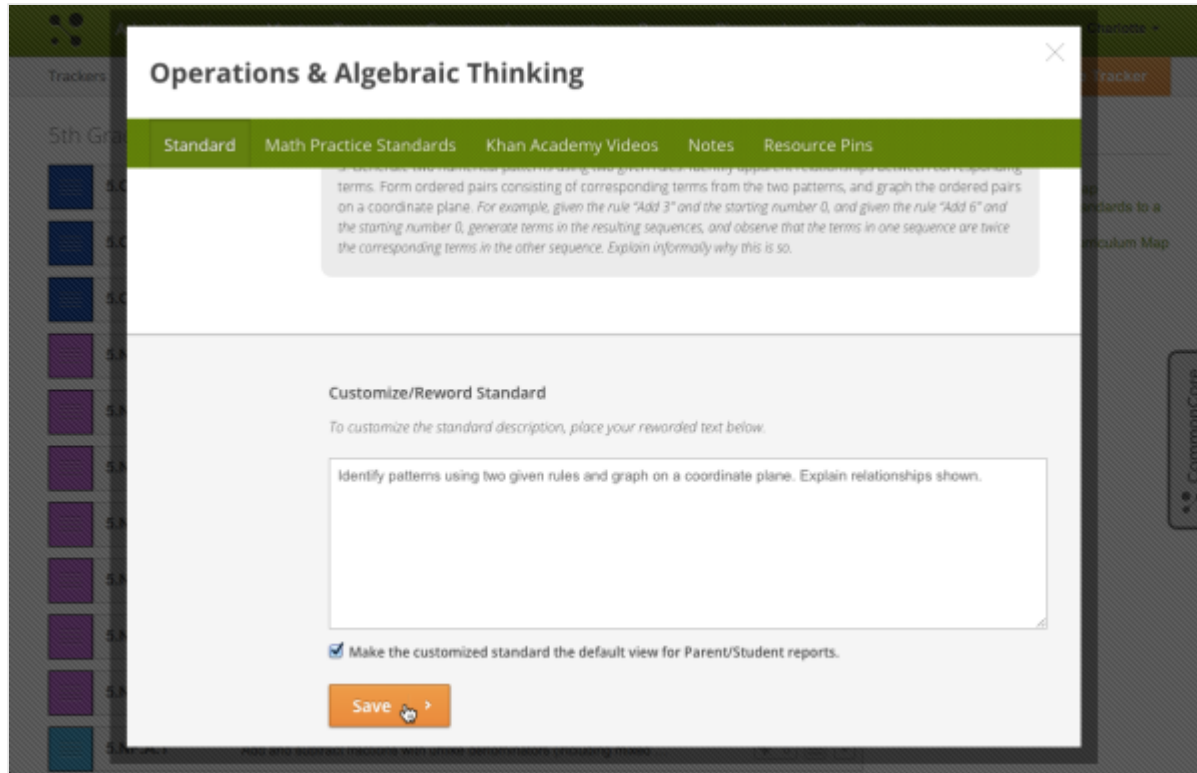
