Dates: January 9, 16, 23, 30

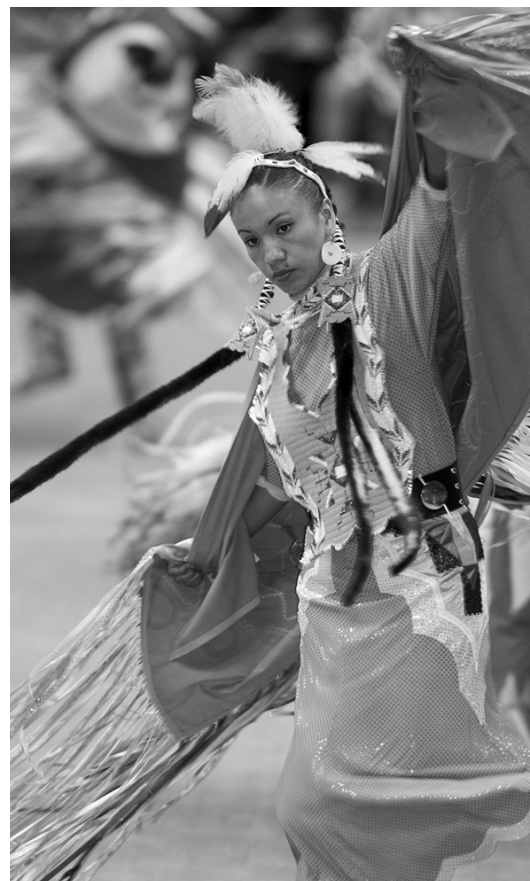
Time: 2:30-7:30 p.m. This is a drop-in class, participants are able to join at anytime.
