- 1 Composition book (journal), wide-ruled
- 1 Notebook, 5-subject, wide-ruled
- 5 Folders, 2-pocket, any colors
- 1 Two-pocket folder, for music
- 1 - 1 inch clearview 3-ring binder
- 1 Reinforced plastic pocket folder for daily travel between home and school (no prongs)
- 36 Pencils, #2 yellow wooden, sharpened, with erasers (more if your child typically runs out)
- 2 Large erasers and pencil top erasers
- 2 Pencil sharpeners that collect shavings
- 1 Box (12 or more) colored pencils, sharpened or twistable colored pencils
- 1 Box thin-tipped markers
- 1 Box 24 crayons
- 1 Set of Crayola watercolors (for art)
- 1 Box odorless dry erase markers, chisel tip (please avoid Crayola brand)
- 2 Pencil pouches
- 1 Pair scissors, pointed tip and good quality, like Fiskars
- 1 Bottle of Elmer's all-purpose glue
- 2 Large or 4 small glue sticks
- Backpack or school bag (no wheeled backpacks; lockers are shared and not enough space)
- Headphones (no earbuds, please), labeled and placed in a labeled Ziploc bag
- 1 Pair of tennis shoes for physical education
- Paint shirt for art class (labeled with child's name)
- 1 or 2 Large boxes of tissues
- 1 Roll of paper towels - optional
- 1 or 2 Large containers of fragrance-free baby wipes
